- ✔ **Work-Life Balance:** Health centers offer regular business hours with minimal to no call or hospital rounds.
- ✔ **Clinical Autonomy:** Clinical decisions are best left to the clinician. You and your healthcare team control your work.
- ✔ **Job Satisfaction:** You are making an impact in your community that you can see in real time by increasing access to healthcare for underserved populations.
- ✔ **Quality of Care:** Healthcare quality data is overseen and reported to the federal government and available to the public.
- ✔ **Loan Repayment:** Multiple federal and state loan repayment programs are available to help you reduce your student debt and focus on doing what you love most – helping others.








What is a Community Health Center?

Community Health Centers, also known as Federally Qualified Health Centers (FQHCs), deliver comprehensive, high-quality primary and preventive care using an innovative care model to keep people healthy. Health centers ensure access to patients regardless of income and insurance status by offering services on a sliding-fee scale. Health Centers improve access to primary care as well as integrated specialty services such as preventive, behavioral health, substance use treatment, oral, vision, and pharmacy services. Additionally, health centers offer a host of ancillary services to support patients' needs around food insecurity, housing, transportation, and language access.

Student Debt Reduction Opportunities

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Pennsylvania Primary Care Loan Repayment Program: Up to \$80,000 in loan repayment for eligible primary care practitioners willing to make a two-year commitment to practice in medically underserved areas.
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National Health Service Corps (NHSC) Program: Up to \$80,000 in loan repayment for eligible primary care practitioners willing to make a two-year commitment to practice in medically underserved areas.
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NHSC Substance Use Disorder Workforce Program: Up to \$80,000 in loan repayment for eligible practitioners working at an approved SUD treatment facility willing to make a three-year service commitment.
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NHSC Rural Community Loan Repayment Program: Up to \$105,000 in loan repayment for eligible practitioners working at an approved rural SUD treatment facility willing to make a three-year service commitment.
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NHSC Students to Service Loan Repayment Program: Up to \$120,000 in loan repayment for eligible students in the last year of medical, nursing, or dental school in return for three years of full-time service at an approved site in a designated health professional shortage area.
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NHSC Scholarship Program: Tuition, eligible education fees, and a monthly stipend for students in eligible academic programs in return for a two to four year service commitment providing primary care services in a designated health professional shortage area.
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Nurse Corps Scholarship Program: Tuition, eligible education fees, and a monthly stipend for nursing students in eligible academic programs in return for a one to two year service commitment working in a critical shortage facility.
